SXC conducts 54 programs for students from the undergraduate to the doctoral level. The admission to programmes such as: B.Com degree, all undergraduate self-financed programmes – Mass Media, Management Studies, Information Technology, all post graduate and PhD programs is based on students selecting the programme at the entry level.

The admission to B.A. and B.Sc. programmes follows a more choice-based approach. Students applying for the B.A. programme, select 3 subjects at the first-year level (of 86 potential combinations on offer), and choose 1 or 2 of the subjects as their major only when they reach the final year. A similar pattern is followed by students applying for the BSc. Programme, where students are offered a choice of any one of 11 different combinations of subjects (each combination with 3 mandatory subjects). At the third- year level they have one subject for single majors and two subjects for double majors. The decision about which subject they will major in, is completely choice and merit based. Admissions at the first year are based on combinations offered rather than programmes.

The <u>overall intake capacity</u> sanctioned by the University of Mumbai is 396 each for first year B.A. and B.Sc. Hence in our data, the applications received are grouped as BA / BSc. The sanction numbers per combination (and indirectly programme) at the first-year level is internally managed every year based on the demand.

The sanctioned intake numbers from the University of Mumbai for admission of students to first year of undergraduate programmes are received by the college at the start of each academic year and implemented in the admission process of the same year. We are hence providing admission data for the 5-year period from 2015/16 to 2019/20.
