AANT0101	Academic enhancement	More time was invested in students exploring the meanings of these concepts in their everyday life and also explore it through their CIA.
AANT0201	Academic enhancement	Making Anthropology relevant and practical by engaging with its application in the contemporary context
AANT0301	Academic enhancement to practical issues	The paper spans two semesters. The first semester, first half is theory-heavy to set the tone for the rest of the semester(s). More grounded ethical dilemmas and case-studies will be introduced to ensure they understand the connection between theory and praxis.

So more real life and topical and easy examples are being incorporated for all to understand irrespective of disciplines and schools/colleges students have come from. So by the second semester they are much more aware and comfortable into the course.
ASOC0301	Clarity of course, takeaway from course	This course flows in conjunction with the TY-Sociological Theory Course, so while some take-away exists, it cannot be evaluated in isolation from ASOC0501 and ASOC0601. This will be better presented to students for the next semester. Some theories will also be better connected to 4th semester papers to ensure the course take-away is understood comprehensively by the end of SYBA in its entirety.
ASOC0301	Clarity of course, academic enhancement	This course was shared with another faculty member. Effort was put to induce interest among students to engage with theory by drawing from their every day experiences in lectures as well as CIA.
ASOC0301	Clarity of course, academic enhancement	Course shared with another professor. Efforts were made to divide topics into smaller, more easily absorbed sections. Extensive examples for everyday life used to demonstrate the applicability of theory. Reiteration of the link between theory, its social and historical context, and current/real world events. Effort made to de-value theorists, and present theory in its significant but not flawless form.

ASOC0302	All criteria: scored less than 3	Course was shared with another professor. Time and efforts have been invested in getting the students to read and discuss more contemporary proceedings so that the application of concepts becomes clearer.
ASOC0302	All criteria: scored less than 3	More time devoted to parsing readings thoroughly. Relevant events and examples from real life brought in to reduce the seeming 'outdated-ness' of the historical section. CIA assignment designed to sharply bring into focus the presence of course topics in the students' own lives.
ASOC0401	Academic enhancement achieved	New updated articles have been introduced that are more current with relation to the themes presented in the syllabus
ASOC0402	All criteria	More class time will be invested in getting students to explore the application of the topics in their everyday life.

Semester 4 has no theory paper so there is a big jump from Semester 3 theory paper to directly Sem 5 paper. Theory then becomes either a burden or something that is not comprehensible enough.
