Five mentee teams were selected to undergo training in three workshops and develop an implementable project plan and skills in leadership. The three workshops addressed the following:

- 1. Concept plan to project plan (6th February 2019)
- 2. Project plan to environmental decision making (16thApril 2019)
- 3. Understanding grassroots operations (15thJuly 2019)

Each workshop had presentations and interactive session(s). In addition, eco-entrepreneurs were invited to speak on their journey and share their success story.

A pitching session and award ceremony was conducted on 25thJuly 2019 to select two teams who could be awarded a grant to implement their project over a three-month period (August, September and October 2019).

Description of the Project

St. Xavier's College, Mumbai (Autonomous) has been awarded a grant to implement the project titled 'Recycling Grey Water after treatment by Electrocoagulation' under the Mentorship Program for Youth Leaders in Environment Conservation (Award No-SIN65018GR0030).

Project Theme:

Water Management

Problem Statement:

Fresh water availability is a crisis worldwide and particularly affects India. The NITI Aayog in a June 2018 study warns that India is facing its 'worst' water crisis in history and the demand is likely to double the supply by 20. Nearly 600 million Indians faced high to extreme water stress in the last year alone. St. Xavier's College, Mumbai, during the month of January to March 2019 faced acute water shortage, due to frequent water cuts and reduced supply from the Municipal Corporation and depletion of the ground water in the in house bore well. To meet the regular needs the college, the college had to incur frequent purchases of tanker water. It is estimated that about 40 to 60 % of fresh water used is discarded as Grey water which can be treated and recycled for non potable use.

Desired Solution:

The project aims to design and develop a modular small scale grey water treatment technology-based on the principle of 'Electrocoagulation'. When electricity is passed through polluted water through sacrificial metal electrodes, the metal ion dissociate in to the water. The dissociated metal ions will attract pollutants and coagulate them. The coagulated floccs formed can be then easily filtered or separated. During this treatment, the polluted water loses its turbidity, COD, BOD and can be reused for flushes, gardening and other non-contact use. This will offset fresh water use in areas where fresh water is not needed and enhance its availability for potable use.

The case in point for implementation is St. Xavier's College, Mumbai (Autonomous). The grey water shall be collected from the hostel building and post treatment the recycled water shall be supplied to the flush tanks in the same building. This can ensure a savings of about 7000 L of fresh water daily and will eventually translate into financial savings spent on fresh water purchase. Last year the college bore approximately Rs. 40,000/- additional cost for fresh water purchase during the water deficient period of 3 months. Efficient recycling will offset this demand and reduce expenditure.

The project will involve design development installation and implementation of an Electrocoagulation unit. Once developed the modular Electrocoagulation unit can be replicated at other residential buildings, individual homes and public toilets. Their utility in the numerous new public toilet constructions is a promising solution to meet the goals of improved sanitation and water savings.

- 2. On conclusion of the project, these equipment/assets may be transferred to the Institution or representatives appointed by the Institution for continuous maintenance.
- The Institution, will ensure that these equipment/assets are continued to be used and maintained in satisfactory condition.

Project Review

- Ekonnect and U.S. Consulate General, Mumbai will conduct two site visits, one during the course of project implementation and second, post the project completion. The mentor will also be present during the project review visit.
- Recommendations suggested by the project review team post site visit will be incorporated suitably into the project.
- Expenses for conduct of the site visit shall be borne by Ekonnect, however the Institution will ensure facilitation of the site visit. Prior intimation of at least seven days will be provided by Ekonnect to the Institution.
- 4. Institution needs to report implementation status to the Mentor on a fortnightly basis with a copy sent to Ekonnect.



This Memorandum of Understanding (MoU) has been arrived at between Biolaxi Corporation Pvt Ltd, Thane and St Xavier's College (Autonomous), Mumbai 400 001, for a project to improve *E. coli* strain for enhanced activity of penicillin G amidase enzyme. This MoU will be effective from 01 October 2018.

The terms of this Memorandum of Understanding are as follows:

Duration and Scope of Work:

The project aims to obtain *E. coli* isolates that produce larger quantities of penicillin G amidase with improved activity and stability. The duration of the project will be three months. The work will be carried out in Caius Research Laboratory (CRL) of St. Xavier's College (Autonomous), Mumbai, under the guidance of Dr. Priya Sudarrajan (Principal Investigator) and Dr. Vishwas Sarangdhar (Consultant).

The work will involve the following aspects:

- A. Mutagenesis of E. coli strain that produces penicillin G amidase;
- B. Selection of clones that produce larger amounts of this enzyme;
- C. Improvement of enzyme stability by using different formulations.

A. Mutagenesis of E. coli strain:

The *E. coli* strain that produces penicillin G amidase will be obtained by Biolaxi Corporation and given to Caius Research Laboratory, St. Xavier's College, Mumbai. The strain will be mutagenized using classical microbiological techniques.

B. Selection of clones that over-produce penicillin G amidase:

After mutagenesis, the *E. coli* cells will be selected on plates with *Serratia* for identification of clones that produce larger amounts of the enzyme.

C. Improvement of enzyme stability:

The clones that over-produce the enzyme will be grown under different environmental conditions. The cells and the enzyme produced will be formulated for improvement in enzyme stability and processivity.

College Infrastructure:

The College agrees to provide all the necessary equipment, such as autoclaves, laminar airflow work-stations, incubators and shakers necessary to carry out microbial work. Any equipment newly purchased for the work to be carried out for this project will be paid for by Biolaxi Corporation and it will remain the property of the Company. The College agrees to surrender the said equipment to the Company at the end of the Project Tenure or at the earlier termination of this Agreement. The chemicals and consumables needed to carry out fermentations and various assays shall be procured as and when required by the college.

Expenditure:

The cost for the work to be carried out at Caius Research Laboratory, St Xavier's College (Autonomous), Mumbai, is as follows (in Indian Rupees):

Timeline:

After the signing of the agreement with Biolaxi Corporation, the work will be carried out as per the following schedule:

Months 1-2 : Mutagenesis of *E. coli* and selection of clones that over-produce penicillin G amidase enzyme.

Months 2-3 : Formulations of cells and/ or the enzyme for improved stability. These will be tested for stability in organic solvents and repeated use.

The clones identified for further process development will be transferred to Biolaxi Corporation. All relevant reference material and standards will be shared with the Company.

Termination of the Project

Memorandum of Understanding

between

Harmony Organics Pvt Ltd, Pune and St. Xavier's College (Autonomous), Mumbai for Improvement of Santalene Synthase Activity

This Memorandum of Understanding (MoU) has been arrived at between Harmony Organics Pvt Ltd, Pune and St. Xavier's College (Autonomous), Mumbai for a project to improve the activity of santalene synthase enzyme. The terms of this Memorandum of Understanding are as follows:

Duration and Scope of Work:

The project aims to obtain improved activity and stability profile for santalene synthase and to develop process parameters to produce santalenes from the precursor, farnesyl pyrophosphate. The duration of the project will be 12 months. The work will be done in Caius Research Laboratory, St. Xavier's College (Autonomous), Mumbai, under the guidance of Dr. Vishwas Sarangdhar.

The work will involve the following aspects:

- A. Synthesis of santalene synthase gene and its expression in E. coli and S. cerevisiae;
- B. Standardization of in-vitro quantitative assays for santalene synthase;
- C. Gene mutagenesis for improvement of enzyme activity and stability.

A. Gene synthesis and expression:

Gene sequence for santalene synthase is available in GenBank and the gene will be commercially synthesized by Harmony Organics Pvt Ltd. The clone will be provided to Caius Research Laboratory, where santalene synthase activity will be demonstrated in vitro by expressing it in *E. coli*. The gene will then be transferred to yeast vector(s) for expression in *S. cerevisiae*. In-vitro enzyme activity of yeast-expressed protein will also be demonstrated.

B. Standardization of in-vitro quantitative assays for santalene synthase:

Using farnesyl diphosphate as substrate, protocols for quantitative estimation of santalenes will be developed using methods such as thin-layer chromatography. The assay will be used to determine the substrate affinity, turn-over rate and stability of the native enzyme.

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C. Improvement of enzyme activity and stability:

After quantitative assays of santalene synthase are standardized, the gene sequence will be mutated using classical mutagenesis techniques, as well as error-prone PCR. The resultant clones will be screened for improvements in enzyme properties with regard to stability, processivity and substrate affinity.

College Infrastructure:

The College agrees to provide all the necessary equipments, such as autoclaves, biosafety class II work-stations, incubators and shakers necessary to carry out microbial work. Any equipment to be purchased for the project will be paid for separately by Harmony Organics Pvt Ltd, and it will remain the property of Harmony Organics Pvt Ltd. The College agrees to surrender the said equipment to Harmony Organics Pvt Ltd at the end of the Project Tenure. The chemicals and consumables needed for the project shall be procured by the College as and when required.

Expenditure:

The cost (in Indian Rupees) for the work to be carried out in the Caius Research Laboratory, St. Xavier's College (Autonomous), Mumbai, is as follows:

Chemicals for enzyme assays and selection of improved clones	1,40,000/-
Plasticware for the same activities	1,95,000/-
Overhead charges to St. Xavier's College, Mumbai	50,000/-

Total 3,85,000/-

(Rupees Three Lakhs Eighty-five Thosuand only)

The payment for this work should be made directly to St. Xavier's College (Autonomous), Mumbai. The costs mentioned above include charges for the use of equipment, materials, electricity, water, etc., in the Caius Research Laboratory and the Central Instrumentation Facility of St. Xavier's College (Autonomous), Mumbai. There is no service tax payable by the College.

The first installment of a sum of INR 1,00,000/- shall be paid at the commencement of the project. After completion of standardization of assays and obtaining a set of bacterial and/or yeast clones (about 3 months), an installment of INR 1,00,000/- shall be paid to the College. The third installment of INR 1,00,000/- shall be paid after six months, and the balance amount of Rs. 85,000/- shall be paid at the completion of the project.

Harmony Organics Pvt Ltd Scope of Work:

Harmony Organics Pvt Ltd will get the santalene synthase gene synthesized commercially and give the clone to Caius Research Laboratory, St. Xavier's College, Mumbai.

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Work to be carried out in the Caius Research Laboratory of St. Xavier's College (Autonomous), Mumbai:

To carry out the research activities for this project, one full-time Project Research Fellow will be appointed for the duration of the project (the payment for personnel is not included in the College expenditure and should be borne separately by Harmony Organics Pvt Ltd). The Research Fellow, under the training and guidance of Dr. Vishwas Sarangdhar, will:

- a) demonstrate in-vitro activity of santalene synthase expressed in *E. coli* and *S. cerevisiae*;
- b) standardize quantitative assays for the same enzyme;
- c) mutagenize the gene sequence and select for clones with improved enzyme performance;
- d) record, document, and compile all data.

Confidentiality:

All records of the work carried out will be kept confidential. For the purpose of this Agreement, "Confidential Information" shall mean all documents, software, databases, materials, tests, investigations conducted by Caius Research Laboratory and information disclosed by Harmony Organics Pvt Ltd to the College at any time during or for the implementation of the present project, including but not limited to trade secrets, business and technical information and data. No Confidential Information in the Scope of Work shall be disclosed to any third party without the prior written consent of Harmony Organics Pvt Ltd. The College agrees that it will not make commercial use of the said Confidential Information received.

Intellectual Property Rights:

No results can be published without a prior written consent from Harmony Organics Pvt Ltd. The Intellectual Property Rights (IPR), if any are derived, will remain solely with Harmony Organics Pvt Ltd.

Timeline:

After the agreement with Harmony Organics Pvt Ltd, the work will be carried out as per the following schedule:

Months 1-3: Cloning and in-vitro demonstration of enzyme activity.

Months 2-5 : Standardization of quantitative assays, and enzyme expression in yeast. Months 4-12: Mutagenesis and selection of clones with improved enzyme activity.

Deliverables:

Month 3 : Establishment of in-vitro assay for santalene synthase.

Month 6 : Quantitative assays for santalene synthase; clones with improved enzyme

activity for process development.

Month 12 : Selected clones with desirable enzyme properties for high yield of santalene.



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Final report will be submitted to Harmony Organics Pvt Ltd along with the clones identified for further process development. All relevant reference material and standards will be shared with Harmony Organics Pvt Ltd.
