

Guidelines for Guidance:

- A diary of the meetings with the guide is to be maintained and submitted to the college at the time of Semester end submissions. Student must note the date, time and brief minutes of the meeting in the diary.
- Should there be any grievances/ irregularity or indiscipline student, the guide is requested to report the same to the coordinator/ HOD immediately. Please find details about the module below:
- The introduction, review of literature, aims and objectives and proposed methodology should be submitted tentatively by 15th of September 2017 (end of Semester III). **
- Evaluation of the project work by the guide for Semester III should be submitted by 15th of September, 2017. Details of the evaluation criteria will be shared with you later.
- Students will have their viva-voce tentatively in 1st week of October.
- The final report with abstract, introduction, aims and objectives, methodology, results, discussion & conclusion should be submitted by March 2018. Schedule for Semester IV will be shared later.

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
