



ITHAKA 2015: A Report

Ithaka 2015 was warmly received by its audience. With a total of 8 shows and 7 performances over its three day span between 30th November through the 1st and 2nd December, Ithaka catered to an audience of more than 1,400 people. The fest put up performances ranging from a variety of genres including comedy, thrillers, romance, historical fiction, and the macabre. Thus Ithaka managed to retain its status as a diverse and powerful theatre and drama festival for one and all.


