





मराठी वाङ्मय मंडळ

मराठी वाडमय मंडळाने २०१८ साली १५व्या वर्षात पदार्पण केले. संत झेवियर्स महाविद्यालयाचे हे एम. व्ही.एम. सातत्याने मराठी संस्कृती लोकांपर्यंत पोचविण्याचे कार्य करीत आहे. कार्यकारिणी मंडळ दरवर्षीप्रमाणे याही वर्षी मराठी भाषा लोकांमध्ये कशी रूजवता येईल आणि जे महाराष्ट्रीयन नाहीत, त्यांच्यात भाषेची गोडी कशी निर्माण करता येईल, ह्याच हेतुने कार्यरत होते.

मराठी संस्कृतीत गुरू-शिष्य ह्या नात्याला सगळ्यात वरचे स्थान दिले आहे. ह्याच परंपरेचा मान आणि शिक्षकांसमोर नतमस्तक होण्याचे संस्कार ह्याची जाणीव सदस्यांनी महाविद्यालयात गुरू पौर्णिमा २८ जुलै या दिवशी साजरी करून दर्शवली. कलेच्या माध्यमातून नाटकाच्या रूपात सर्व शिक्षकांचे आभार मानण्यात आले.

दर वर्षाच्या परंपरेनुसार २०१८ सालचे मराठी वाडमय मंडळाचे कार्य हे एका मोठ्या उदघाटन समारंभाने दिनांक १९ सप्टेंबरला चालू झाले. मंडळाचे काम हे नाट्य, नृत्य, संगीत, साहित्य, कला अशा विभागांमध्ये चालते. मंडळाच्या सदस्यांनी लाइव्ह मूवी ही नवीन कल्पना रंगमंचावर प्रस्तुत केली. एकाच नाटकात सर्व कला दर्शविल्या व प्रेक्षकांना रममाण होण्यास भाग पाडले. हा

कार्यक्रम प्राचार्य राजेंद्र शिंदे व मंडळाच्या अध्यक्षा प्रा. अनिता राणे यांच्या उपस्थितीत पार पडला.

२०१८ साली महाविद्यालयाला १५० वर्षे पूर्ण झाली आणि सर्वत्र महोत्सव सूरू होता. मंडळाने ह्या महोत्सवात देखील स्वतःचा उसा दर्जेदारपणे उमटवला. नृत्य विभागाने लेझीम व गोंधळ हे साजरे केले.

मुंबईकरांसाठी २६ नोव्हेंबर हा अतिशय महत्त्वाचा दिवस असतो. मुंबईत झालेल्या दहशतवादी हल्ल्यात अनेकजण ठार झाले व शहीद होज्जन भारताच्या इतिहासात अजरामर झाले. या शूरवीरांना अध्दांजली म्हणून मंडळाने शौर्यदिन साजरा केला. शौर्य दिनानिमित्त जे लोक त्या प्रसंगाला सामोरे गेले, त्यातील काही लोकांच्या मुलाखती घेण्यात आल्या. ह्या कार्यक्रमाच्या प्रस्तुतीनंतर मात्र प्रेक्षक हादरून गेले होते. शहिद झालेल्यांना आदरांजली म्हणून महाविद्यालयात कॅंडल मार्च देखील आयोजित करण्यात आला.

वर्षाच्या अखेरीस मंडळाने स्वतःच्या वार्षिक उत्सवाचे म्हणजेच आमोदचे दिनांक २१, ३० आणि ३१ जानेवारीला मंडळाने आयोजन केले होते. सर्व कलांना उददेशून अनेक आंतर महाविद्यालयीन स्पर्धा आयोजित करण्यात आल्या. आमोदसाठी सिने इंडस्ट्रितील कलाकार रेणुका शहाणे, श्रीहरी कुलकर्णी परीक्षक म्हणून लाभले. आमोदच्या प्रस्तुतीने आणि सुंदर आयोजनाने स्पर्धकांना व प्रेक्षकांना अचंबित केले. याचबरोबर भारतीय डिजिटल पार्टी यांच्या सदस्यांचा कार्यक्रम पण महाविद्यालयात झाला.

या सर्व कार्यक्रमांबरोबर विद्यालयाच्या लिंगवा या सर्व भाषीय महोत्सवात पण मंडळाचा सहभाग होता. तिथे लावणी, भारूड, पोवाडा या कला सादर करून सर्वांना मराठी संस्कृतीची नव्याने ओळख करून दिली.

मराठी भाषेचा गौरव म्हणून मंडळाने मराठी भाषा दिवस दिनांक २७ फेब्रुवारी मोठ्या दिमाखात साजरा केला. मराठी भाषेच्या दिग्गज कवींना, लेखकांना स्मरून मंडळाच्या सदस्यांनी ते मराठी असल्याचा त्यांना अभिमान वाटतो आणि सर्वांना वाटला पाहिजे हे लोकांना आपल्या कार्यक्रमांतून सांगण्याचा प्रयत्न केला. मराठी अभिमान गीत गाऊन या कार्यक्रमाची सांगता करण्यात आली.

Report-Lingua 2018

Lingua 2018- Date: 27th November 2018 to 1st December 2018

Lingua 2018 was curated in lieu of Xavier's celebrating its 150th year, to create a platform which connects readers to experiences that celebrate the culture of ideas and imagination. We strived to bear on our shoulders the phenomenal legacy of *Antas*, the eclectic charm of *Ithaka* and the fabled rootedness of the *Marathi Vagmay Mandal* while creating the multilanguage, 5 day literary extravaganza

In its very first edition, the vision for Lingua 2018 was to create a platform conducive for all storytellers to tell us their chronicles, no matter the language of their choice. They used the stage as a page-and used the most potent tool to connect us to the events beyond our experience and worlds beyond our own. In addition to incredible theatre with a total of 8 plays from all three languages, we had an enigmatic telling of partition through our Hindi musical *Laqeer*, classical renditions of the *Lavani* performed masterfully, stalwarts such as Shreyas Talpade and Ashwin Sanghi discussing language elitism and the contemporary communication of ancient myths, an elaborate Bollywood Orchestra and a Disney style French musical. Thus, Lingua 2018 catered to every nuanced palette.

Lingua also featured activities that were off the beaten path- such as a traditional Marathi cuisine tasting event, a Bollywood quiz and *Antakshri* for film geeks and a resurrection of outdoor Indian games such as *Lagor*i and *Kho-Kho*. We were also regaled with the compositions of our specially abled contemporaries as they took centerstage while telling the stories of the heroes from Maharastra through the art of *Bharud* and amateur poets who were challenged to take on the greats by retelling the English classics in their own words. At Lingua 2018, we tried to feature parallel narratives from our indigenous cultures that make for stories that deserve to be told. We hope to have told stories that made a difference and maybe even ushered in our own little revolution of thought.

Lingua 18-A Report from the English Department

Lingua 2018 was home to some incredible plays that elicited a range of emotions from the audience. From 27th November to 1st December, 2018, St. Xavier's was truly transformed to a literary wonderland by the collaboration of the French, Hindi, Marathi and English Departments of the College. The English Department hosted a heart wrenching play adapted from "Only Goodness" by Jhumpa Lahiri, directed by Sahir D'souza, where we see the story of Sudha Ganguly, her younger brother Rahul and a consuming addiction - one, that, over time, threatens families, lives, and close ties.

Another play was the retelling on a classic, The Arms and the Man, directed by Malavika Selvaraj, Joanna Johnson and Sonal Joshi. It shows us how the lives of four very different people -Raina, our protagonist, Louka, the defiant, headstrong maid, Sergius, Raina's fiancé, and Bluntschli, an enemy soldier-are altered through its events.

A fresh script, a theatrical thriller. Sophia, an eponymous play, directed by Saniya Pathare and Anushka Benny, shows us a complex character right from the start, who is struggling with memories of a traumatic past, amid the seemingly perfect parts of her life, and is faced with the dilemma of exploring these memories, or pushing them behind her.

And finally, we touched upon the futuristic genre with the play 'Artificially Yours', directed by Taran Warner and Shaan Pasricha, which centres around the debate of what it means to be 'human'. The play introduces us to the Olsen family, who are falling apart, and cannot seem to feel any compassion or love, and how their young daughter struggles to build a connection with her own family.
