ANTAS 2019 REPORT

Antas-Jashn Hunar Ka was a two-day intra-collegiate festival of the Department of Hindi organised on 27th and 28th November, 2019, which observed a footfall of 1000 (approximately). Other than the several Sahitya, Natya and Sangeet activities organised on the mentioned two days, several pre-Antas activities such as Dandiya Night, Hindi Poetry Writing Contest, Bollyhop Dance Workshop (conducted by Ajinkay Thakur- an established choreographer, MMA fighter and entrepreneur), Nautanki Chowk, Open Mic, Treasure Hunt and Voice Modulation Workshop (conducted by Mr. Sandeep Karnik from 'My Voice Academy') were also organised over a span of fifteen days prior to the fest. During the time, a blog named "Qissa-e-Antas" was also started to provide a platform to all the budding artists in and outside college. A few distinguished guests were also invited to these events such as the famous poets Gaurav Tripathi and Darshan Rajpurohit.

Day 1: 27th November, 2019

The first day of the Antas started at 2:30PM with "Dialogue Writing Competition", wherein 8 teams participated. Further the day had in store three plays which were staged in the College Hall from 2:40PM onwards namely, "Berang", "Kanda", "Aghasur". All the plays were written, directed and acted by the students of the college. Berang was a drama revolving around a society we all live in, a society we are all tired of, a society where having an opinion is considered important but has no value. Kanda was a story of Kaashi Rao who was felicitated with the "Progressive Farmer of the Year" award by the Chief Minister of Maharashtra in 2017. Finally, Aghasur was a suspense drama about a man's journey and his struggle to achieve his dreams as a dancer. Mrs. Jyoti Tomar, a well-established choreographer and was invited as the chief guest for the plays. Malhar 2019: The Multiverse-ANexus of Possibilities

The day began with the first Keynote address by Sir William Mark Tully, the former bureau chief of BBC, New Delhi. In his address 'India's Past, Present and Future. He repeatedly emphasised the essential nature of autonomous institutions in the smooth functioning of a democracy. Dr. Srinath Raghavan, a historian and a strategic affairs analyst dwelled on 'The Relevance of Military and Strategic History in Contemporary Times'. The most significant highlight of Malhar Conclave 2019 was the second Keynote session 'From Criminal to Citizen- LGBT+rights in India'. by Ms. Arundhati Katju, the lead advocate in the decriminalisation of Section 377. Coincident with the announcement of the Jal Jeevan Mission by the Hon. Prime Minister of India in New Delhi; Malhar conclave 2019 hosted a panel discussion on the water crisis in India. The esteemed panel for 'The War Over Water: India's Worrisome Future' included Dr. Jayanta Bandyopadhyay, researcher, author and analyst, Mr. Shripad Dharmadhikary, a full-time activist for Narmada Bachao Andholan, Mr. Chandra Bhushan, an environmentalist and prolific researcher, Mr. Samrat Basak, a Hydrgeologist. The debate was moderated by Ms. Keya Acharya, the President of the Forum of Environmental Journalists in India. The second panel discussion focussed on 'Women in Sports-Levelling the Playing Field'. It consisted of Pinki Jangra, a fly weight boxer from Haryana who secured the bronze at the Glasgow Commonwealth Games; Vaidehi Vaidya, an engineer by profession and a sports enthusiast who founded the Forum of Women In Sports; Aparna Popat, a national badminton champion for 9 years straight; and Sanika Divekar, a national table tennis player and sports psychologist. K Shriniwas Rao, sports editor of The Times of India was the moderator for this panel. On the occasion of Independence Day, Malhar Conclave 2019 hosted an interactive session with the crew of INSV Tarini, the first Indian all women team to circumnavigate the Earth. The crew headed by Lt. Cdr. Vartika Joshi consisted of Lt. Cdr. Pratika Jamwal, Lt. Cdr. Vijaya Devi and Lt. Cdr. Payal Gupta.

Social Cause: Malhar, inaugurated its operations with a Tree Plantation Drive at Vikhroli along the Eastern Express Highway in collaboration with the NGO Green Umbrella on the






