Mentoring process: Faculty training Organised by Wellness centre, St. Xavier's College, Mumbai

Date: 5th July 2019

Report on the Mentoring Session for the teachers of the arts faculty who will be mentoring the FY students: - By Fr Francis, Director, Wellness Centre.

The academic year 2019-20 commenced on 10th June 2019 and our new batch of young first year students started classes after the admission process on 28th June 2019. Adjusting to a new college for many and a new city for some is not an easy task. A little bit of hand holding, emotional support, academic guidance etc goes a long way in creating happy and confident students ready to soar to great heights.

As has always been the practice, this year also, teachers engaging the first-year students were assigned around 25 students for mentoring. Fr Francis de Melo, Director of Wellness Centre, facilitated a training session on mentoring students for these teachers. A total of 18 teachers attended the program. Fr Francis began with an explanation of the need for mentoring – to help students reach their cherished and desired goals in their years in college. He emphasized the fact that students need assistance in believing that they can achieve much more than they would normally think of and they need assistance in getting to those goals. The areas of mentoring would be 3 – academic, skill development and personal issues. It was proposed that each teacher meet the respective student twice a semester for about 15 minutes. There would be a common orientation session to this offer of mentoring following which the students would be free to avail of the opportunity being provided. Fr. Francis made a few suggestions about an invitation that could be given to each student which would clarify the matter for these mentoring sessions. Students would be left free to share what they feel. He also explained that we would use the gradual projects approach to achieving these goals. He provided teachers with a hand-out, a sort of template that could be used. The students would be encouraged to maintain a journal of their projects, a record of the step-by-step approach that they are following in achieving their goals. One important issue that came up from the teachers was that in the case of a student requiring extra attention, especially for emotional issues, professional help would need to be provided. This was clarified by Fr. Francis that anyone who needed such help

Report: A workshop on 'Orientation to Apple Apps' was conducted for new teachers on 5th February 2020 and other teachers on 6th February 2020. The resource person for the workshop was Mr. Shibu George from Apple. The workshop aimed at orienting teachers for accession, distribution, and creation of content using Apple iPad. All the participants were provided with an iPad for hands-on training.

The workshop started with a brief video session demonstrating the use of Apple in the education field using a classroom app which is a versatile teaching assistant that puts teachers in charge of every iPad and Mac in the classroom, so they can keep students on track (www.apple.com/education). This app helps teachers with various tasks like easy distribution and collection of assignments, keeping an eye on student progress in educational apps, and collaborating one on one with students from anywhere, in real-time. Apple School Manager (school.apple.com) can be used by the institutes for creating classrooms for various courses.

Participants got an opportunity to explore free apps on the iPad like iTunes U, Garage band, Camera, etc. The app iTunes U is a large collection of the free education content in public courses from leading schools, universities, museums and cultural institutions. During the workshop use of Keynote application which is equivalent to Microsoft PowerPoint was demonstrated and used for the creation of a small presentation as an example. The sharing of files between multiple iPad users was also demonstrated during this interactive and hands-on

(word processor) and Numbers (spreadsheet) was also demonstrated. 'Explain edu' (a version of a whiteboard for iPad and iPhone), is a paid app that can be used for the creation of E-content. This app was pre-installed on the iPads provided and participants got an opportunity to use this app for sample content creation. Mr. Shibu also mentioned the iMovie app, which is simple, easy to use a video editing program that comes free with the Apple operating system and offers many features like dropping clips on a timeline, cropping them, adding transitions between clips, etc. This can be used for creating demonstration videos for science practical sessions.
