





Background:

Pedagogic research is crucial to teaching-learning-assessment due to the changing paradigms in higher education. Innovative research skills and methodologies for systematic experiential learning is the need of the hour. Giving a new perspective to the faculties' current experiences of teaching and learning will be a steppingstone in this direction.

Objective: To give an insight to navigate from scientific research to educational research.

Workshop summary:

Pedagogy focuses on teaching – who and what is taught and how it is taught. It is now becoming mandatory that all who engage in teaching within higher education adopt a scholarly approach to their teaching – that is, as professionals they reflect on and seek to improve their practice. With the objective to understand the nuances of pedagogic research 36 science faculty members attended the seminar.

Dr. Deepti Gupta was formally introduced and felicitated of by Dr. Karuna Gokarn. Dr. Deepti began the seminar with an introspective question to the group " Are you a good teacher?". Some of the key characteristics that defined a good teacher discussed were inquisitiveness, patience, subject expertise and capacity to reduce complexities of a concept .

She then steered the discussion towards pedagogic research and its intricacies. The difference between academic research and educational research was well explained during the seminar. It was encouraging to understand the possibility of engaging in different levels of investigation or scholarship in order to enhance our understanding of the student experience and our own practice. After giving an overview about the scholarship of teaching -learning, the participants were divided into groups based on their broad subject areas and provided with research papers to discuss.

The groups were expected to present the discussion based on the key indicators of research:

- ✓ Research Question
- ✓ Research Method
- ✓ Data Source
- ✓ Tools used
- ✓ Result evaluation

A 30-minute brain storming session led to the presentations from each group. Using the examples presented, Dr. Deepti explained the various research tools and documentation methods that can be used for pedagogic research. The introduction of discipline based educational research (DBER) and Course based undergraduate research experiences (CURE) was an eye opener for the participants.

IQAC Seminar for Staff Members on 4/10/'16

Details of group discussion on hopes for education to bring about transformation for all parties involved

- We believe that personal, intellectual, social and spiritual transformation are all a part of the same continuum. Focusing on any will automatically impact the others.
- Teachers and students need to actively inculcate time management skills as that is
 essential to reduce stress in our academic setup.
- As teachers, we need to consciously recognize whether we are encouraging the development of empathy and sensitivity or programming robots.
- Teachers have to be positive and proactive while preparing for and taking classes on FC/PHV for science students. Their disinterest will detriment the purpose of these courses, especially for the BSc. students.
- Knowledge should be integrative in approach so that its applicability is understood. For eg.- issues of water conservation should be approached from both a scientific and sociological perspective.
- Teachers should present fact in an impersonal manner and let students form their own opinions. Personal biases and ideologies are detrimental to an organic growth of one's intellectual and spiritual faculties.

Faculty Seminar on Adapting to change

Date: 10-03-2017

'Inclusion' as a theme was adopted by the Institution and to enable this, the XRCVC created and shared the structure of an Inclusion Cell to be set up at St Xavier's College. The XRCVC, already well known for the involvement with the vision impaired students was expanding their target group to student with disabilities (SWD) in order that a greater inclusive environment is established in the campus. One of the first initiatives taken up by the Inclusion Cell was to sensitize the faculty to a 'disability'.

To achieve this, a daylong seminar "Adapting to change" was held for the Senior College faculty. There were three sessions presented; two in the morning and one session was post lunch.

The first one - *Building Inclusion* – *The Disability Perspective* was presented by Ms Neha Trivedi and Dr Sam Taraporevala of the XRCVC and Prof Linda Dhakul from the Department of Psychology. In a very interactive way the resource persons got the audience to feel the experience and understand a 'disability'.

The second one - *Mentoring the Digital Natives* was facilitated by Dr Jehangir Mistry, from the XIC. Dr Mistry used multiple devices exposing the faculty to the 'digital level' of inclusion in our traditional teaching approach.

The third session - What the student needs, was managed by a team from Teach for India. This non-profit NGO believes in providing equal opportunities for all children to attain an excellent education. The NGO trains youngsters to serve as full-time teachers to children from low-income communities in under-resourced schools. The dedication and commitment that these youngsters have to develop young minds and towards academic excellence and personal growth was evident when the team of facilitators and students of a Mumbai Municipal school led by Ms Romana Shaikh, enthralled the faculty with their unique participative presentation. The day transitioned from sensitizing faculty to students with disabilities to incorporating a digital world ending with an intense insight into what the outcomes achieved when socio-economic background children attain when given opportunities. Truly "inclusion"!

Abstract

Purpose of the talk is to jointly explore the possibility of going beyond the educational goals of understanding and application to the somewhat challenging but valuable goals of deep understanding, critical thinking, inquiry, and integration.

If we keep these goals in focus then we can see the examples of syllabus specifications, classroom activities, teaching-learning materials, and assessment tasks that are oriented towards the above educational goals, and have a discussion during/after each example.

If we stay focused on these educational goals, then we may explore the possibility of introducing either a one semester course or a 15 contact hour module on critical thinking, inquiry, and integration in the first semester of the first year of the undergrad program. This would in effect be an introduction to research without assuming in-depth knowledge of the subject matter.
