❖ Overview of Landscaping in the College Campus

St. Xavier's College (Autonomous), Mumbai, is known for its beautiful landscaping with trees and plants, just as it is known for its heritage structure. The college campus includes green spaces embellished with several native and non-native tree species, fruit trees, flowering and decorative plants and trees and plants of medicinal value. The biodiversity across campus not only ensures a noise-free campus off the main arterial road outside, but also maintains a cool environment inside the college premises. The trees attract a variety of birds, insects and other fauna. The green spaces in college are lovingly nurtured by college gardener Mr Narayan Rambade.

Right at the entrance to the grand edifice of the college building is the **Front Garden** beautified with a variety of flowering and green plants and trees like coconut palms, amla, jamun, jackfruit, mango, papaya and neem trees. A beautiful pariijaat tree creates a white-orange carpet at the centre of the front garden. At the edges of the front garden are trees like tamarind, adulsa, noni on one side and kailashpati, akashneem white silk cotton and banyan trees on the other. The beautiful front garden leads on to the front porch of the main college building, a fitting green welcome into the cool environs of this hallowed institute.

Entering the main building, moving towards the college canteen through the reception area, the 'first quad' with the basketball court and passing by the College Hall, one chances upon the soulful **Peace Garden** to the right. This garden is so named because of the 'Peace Pole' dug deep into the ground with the inscription 'May Peace Prevail on Earth'. The beautiful landscaping is thanks to a generous alumna and regular maintenance by Onward Technologies. A beautiful pebbled path runs through the Peace Garden. There are stone benches for students and staff to relax amidst the greenery. The common Staff Room overlooks the Peace Garden over the volley ball court. Staff members are seen to relax with their cup of tea and coffee or simply relax gazing at the green trees. The garden has traditional species like mango, amla, jackfruit, banana, kunti and coconut. It has the champa (*Plumeria*) and red bead trees. The Peace Garden is lined on two sides by fan palms that add to its beauty. A walk through this beautiful landscape simultaneously calms and pleases the mind.

Crossing the college foyer and canteen area, one enters the **Woods**, the favourite haunt of students and staff across batches, across generations. Among this wooded landscape, life long memories are made. The Woods are so named because of the dense canopy that is present here. Tall trees like Bakul, Coconut, Sonchapha, Kokum, Christmas tree, as also the Jaam, Sitaphal, and Papaya grow in close proximity. Below the dense canopy are smaller flowering plants and croton species. This area has a tiled ledge that is often used as a seating space by students to eat their lunch, drink a beverage or simply sit and chat. The dense canopy provides shade from the hot sun and also provides a musical background with several birds singing on the tree branches. Across the Woods lining the undergraduate Chemistry laboratories are Ixora, crotons, the Devil's tree and Fan palms. Lining the XIC building are yellow and pink Oleander, Aboli, Bougan villae and the Ramphal tree.

The tiled area adjacent to the wooded one had at one time lawn grass growing between the tiles, giving it a soothing green touch. The Woods remain the most visited spot of the college campus by all students.

In addition to these three green spaces in college, the Department of Botany also maintains a **Cacti and Grass garden** and a **mini Pond**. The various cacti species and the beautiful pond water ecosystem with its typical plant species and guppy fish add beauty to the entire third floor terrace. The grasses also attract birds like munia, and beautiful Snowflake lilies blossom in the pond during the season.



I, the Rector and the authorized signatory of St. Xavier's College located at 5, Mahapalika Marg, Dhobi Talao, Chhatrapati Shivaji Terminus, Fort, Mumbai – 400001 ("College") hereby acknowledge and confirm that Onward Foundation, a trust registered under the Bombay Public Trusts Act, 1950 ("Onward Foundation") has donated towards improvement of educational facilities of the College by renovating and purchasing upgraded equipment at Onward Foundation's cost, being a total of Rs. 28,48,283/- (Rupees Twenty Eight Lakhs Forty Eight thousand two hundred and eighty three only), paid directly by them to the vendors ("Contribution"). Details of the expenses towards the renovations and equipment purchase are set out in Exhibit 1 attached to this letter.

Obligations:

- I, on behalf of the College hereby confirm and undertake that the College authorities will comply with the following requirements in lieu of the aforesaid Contribution for a period of 5 years commencing 1st February 2020 and ending 1st February 2025 (“Term”):
 - a) Rename the Audio-Visual hall on the ground floor across the canteen to:
Onward Hall
Curated in the memory of Mrs. Shaila H. Mehta (Alumna of St. Xavier’s College).
 - b) Place 2 display signs in the college second quad garden area stating “Beautification by Onward Technologies”, as provided and refreshed by Onward Foundation from time to time during the Term.
 - c) Place a display sign outside the Sociology Department of the college which will read as ‘Renovated and Maintained by Onward Foundation’, which Onward Foundation reserves the right to refresh with any other display message from time to time during the Term
 - d) The College undertakes that it will not propose any change to the name of the above-mentioned hall, and or remove or change the display signs without prior written approval of Onward Foundation during this term.

Maintenance:

- It is Onward Foundation’s intention to ensure quality and usability of the aforesaid original renovation/beautification work carried out basis the Contribution through the duration of the Term, except for the maintenance of the garden area
- It is clarified that any additional upgradation, repair, etc work required by the College beyond the original work done basis the Contribution will be considered out of scope for any maintenance e.g. changing colour of walls, adding more equipment, etc.
- The College has agreed and decided to maintain the renovated garden internally at the responsibility and cost of the College

Liability:

The College acknowledges and agrees that Onward Foundation has proactively aided improvement in educational facilities of the College by renovating and purchasing upgraded equipment at Onward Foundation’s cost. Installation of all equipment has been done by respective vendors without any inspection by Onward Foundation. In no event, Onward Foundation shall be liable for any loss or damage to property, personal injury or death arising out of any work done or equipment installed.

Governance:

To keep matters simple, this letter shall be interpreted and governed in all respects by the laws of India and the courts of Mumbai alone and no other courts shall be entitled to entertain and try any dispute or matter relating to or arising out of this letter.

You are assigned to work as a gardener. Your usual working hours will be from 8.00 a.m. to 4.30 p.m., however whenever there is any need, you are expected to remain present and be available for any service.

We will also expect you to be available for any other manual work as and when required. You will be subject to the supervision of the Administrator who will assign you duties and responsibilities.

Your appointment is exclusively an appointment of the Trust. You are not under the purview of the University of Mumbai. If you wish to leave the institute, you shall be required to give one month prior notice in writing before leaving the institute.
