


#### Description:



#### Description:

Contemporary discourse on the environment invariably pitches it against development, especially in the urban context. From Metro car sheds to coastal highways, the destruction of the environment is the cost we are apparently asked to pay for urbanisation. Thus, issues of ecology and conservation are seen as burdens on the ambitions of a "land-starved" city like Mumbai. Is it possible to subvert the binary of economic growth vs. environmental sustainability? Can urban development coexist with a sense of responsibility towards our natural resources?

Recent people's movements have shown us that environmental activism does not necessarily have to be "anti-development". However, for active citizenry to have an impact on city-building efforts, we need to break the barrier between people and the state. Mumbai's new development plan, while flawed, invited suggestions from the public. This type of a collective engagement is a start towards a more holistic, sustainable urban environment policy.

Thus, Niti-Samvaad 2018 deconstructs the binary between the environment and development, and between the public and government in an interactive panel discussion with environmental activists, academics, civic officials and city planners. # **Memorandum of Understanding**

This Memorandum of Understanding ("MOU") is made and executed on 1 FEB 2018 at Mumbai.


#### **BETWEEN**

Centre for Environmental Research and Education (CERE) a not-for-profit organization, registered under the Bombay Public Trusts Act of 1950 (Regd. No. E – 20674) having its registered office at S-11, Ground Floor, Jamasji Apartments, 32 Naushir Bharucha Marg (Sleater Road), Grant Road (W), Mumbai – 400 007 (hereinafter referred to as "CERE" which expression shall mean and include its successors and permitted assigns) of the One Part

And

St. Xaviers College – Autonomous, Mumbai which is an autonomous institution with NAAC accredited A:3.63 and designated UGC College of Excellence from 1<sup>st</sup> April 2014 and has The Blatter Herbarium, established in 1906, which is an internationally recognized herbarium for Taxonomic studies and allied branches in Botany, situated at 5, Mahapalika Marg, Dhobi Talao, Fort, Mumbai 400 001 (herein referred to "St. Xaviers College" which expression shall mean and include its successors and permitted assigns) of the Other Part.

#### WHEREAS

- 1. CERE is engaged in promoting environmental sustainability through education and research.
- 2. St. Xavier's College is a teaching and research institution with a well-established Department of Botany.

- 3. CERE desires to undertake a field project study to determine the carbon sequestration potential of existing tree plantations across 6 cities in India in order to compute the carbon offset value for all the trees grown by a company Foundation ("Project").
- 4. St. Xavier's College has considerable knowledge and expertise in the field of plant species identification, geotagging and statistical analysis of existing plantations and has expressed a desire to partner and assist CERE in executing the Project.
- 5. The Parties are desirous of entering into an arrangement whereby CERE would provide financial assistance for field work related to the Project while CERE will undertake carbon data analysis independently in-house, as per the details more fully set out in **Schedule A** hereto.
- 6. The Parties are desirous of recording the terms and conditions of their partnership with this agreement.

#### NOW THIS MOU WITNESSTH AS FOLLOWS:

#### 1. Terms and Conditions of Funding of the Project:

- a) As per the mutual agreement between the Parties, CERE shall provide St. Xavier's College with financial assistance upto the amount and in the manner set out in Schedule B hereto ("Details and Terms of the Financial Assistance") for the Project.
- b) St. Xavier's College agrees to utilize the Financial Assistance solely for the Project and in an ethical, diligent and cost effective manner.

#### 2. Effective Date and Tenure:

This MOU shall be deemed to be effective from 1st February 2018 ("Effective Date"). Unless terminated earlier, this MOU shall be initially valid upto the end of the project or latest 31st May, 2018 ("Termination Date"). This MOU may be extended for such further period as may be mutually agreed to in writing between the Parties. In case of termination of this MOU prior to its expiry, the Parties shall be bound to fulfill their obligations due upto the date of termination of the MOU. Any excess/advance amount which CERE may have provided to St. Xavier's College by way of Financial Assistance shall be refunded to CERE, forthwith upon such early termination but no later than 30 days from the date of termination.

# 3. Roles & Obligations of CERE under the Project:

- a) CERE's role in the Project shall be to provide Financial Assistance as set out herein.
- b) CERE shall jointly monitor progress of the entire Project to ensure all field work is completed in a scientific, professional and expeditious manner in order to meet set project schedule and deadlines.

# 4. Roles & Obligations of St. Xavier's College under the Project:

- a) It shall be the sole responsibility of ... Xavier's College to complete the Project within the timelines set out in Schedule A. St. Xavier's College shall utilize the Financial Assistance only for the Project. Any use of the Financial Assistance otherwise than for the Project shall constitute a material breach of this MOU and shall entitle CERE to forthwith terminate the MOU.
- b) St. Xavier's College agrees to provide CERE with any such primary data sets, data analysis, information, reports, etc. as it may require from time to time in connection with the Project, its progress and the utilization of the Financial Assistance for the Project no lateral than 7 days from the date of Project completion or receipt of a request for the same

· CERE or such extended period as may be mutually agreed to between the Parties.

c) St. Xavier's College shall conduct the Project in the most ethical manner and with due scientific rigour and strictly in accordance with the terms agreed to herein. Any modification to the Project or its details shall be done only with the mutual consent of the Parties to be recorded in writing.

#### 5. Communication:

- a) Neither Party will use the trade name, trademark, logo or other marks or representations of the other Party without prior written approval of the other Party.
- b) Neither Party shall issue any formal public statement, press release or announcement or publication regarding this MOU and/or Project without prior written approval from the other Party.
- c) However, both parties may publish the details of the Project and its association with the Project in its internal newsletters, house journals, intranet, annual report and websites without approval from the other Party.

#### 6. Copyrights:

a) The entire copyright and all other intellectual property rights in the entire Project shall solely vest with CERE.

#### 7. Confidentiality and Non-Disclosure:

- a) CERE and St. Xavier's College agree not to disclose any information of a confidential nature received from the other party, including but not limited to the names/particulars/data of organisations / companies / clients with which CERE or St. Xavier's College may be working, business plans and other competitively sensitive information.
- b) St. Xavier's College and/or its designated researchers have no rights to disclose any information or make reference to the company Foundation who has sponsored the tree plantation across 6 cities of India and for whom CERE is determining the carbon sequestration potential.
