Approval of minutes held on 27th April 2023

• A resolution to pass the minutes of the meeting was proposed by Dr. Geeta Ibrahim and seconded by Dr. Aldon Fernandes.

Action Taken Report: 27th April - 7th July 2023

- The Government Resolution on NEP guidelines was received on 20th April 2023. accordingly the amendments had to be made in the NEP syllabus. There were changes in the number of credits for Arts. The Government Resolution for the PG courses came on 16th May 2023, and the NEP structure for PG courses was also to be amended from the current academic year 2023-2024.
- The entrance exams for the unaided UG and PG courses were conducted smoothly.
- The College re-opened for the SY & TY from 12th June 2023, and the classes started on 13th June 2023. The College for FY started on 7th July 2023.
- In the FYBA, 373 students were admitted. Admissions for all the quotas were completed except for the Management quota. In the Bachelor of Science, 412 students' admission to all the quotas has been completed. In B. Com 200 students were admitted and 56 student admission to BAF. Management quota admissions were in process.
- Fees for all the courses will increase by 20-25%. The fees for M.Sc. Physics and BAF were not increased.
- Marathi subject has been introduced under NEP. The courses under IKS and VEC will be in hybrid mode.
- The Graduation Ceremony for the UG and PG Courses was held on 30th June and 1st July 2023. The Chief Guest on the first day was Mr. Khalid Ansari. On the second day, the Chief guests were Dr. Vinayak Nipun and Dr. Aashish Bhasin.
- The Orientation Programme for the First-Year students was held on 4th, 5th & 6th July 2023. NEP was explained to the parents and the students.
- The Malhar and ECC Committees have started working already.
- SIP mandatory under NEP.
- Dr. Neelam Shetty designed the 'Work-life-balance' survey. The teaching and nonteaching staff filled in their responses. 70 staff members responded.
- Implications for IQAC: Create more opportunities for departments with fewer people, The Wellness Centre plays a pivotal role. Taking care of personal needs, the financial well-being of the staff, and regular health check-ups are important.
- The Environmental Audit for 2022-23 has been completed.

- Under the Empowered Autonomy status, the degree certificate issued to the students by the University of Mumbai will have the College logo with the University of Mumbai logo.

Plans Ahead:

- PG admission process to be started for the aided courses. Classes to begin by 1st August 2023. Interim Academic Council meetings for approval of syllabi for PG courses under NEP.
- A workshop for the Non-Teaching Staff and the new teachers on 'Time Management'.
- Socializing opportunity for the Staff picnic.
- Annual Academic and Administrative Audit: We look forward to conducting it.
- Applications for the Paramarsh Scheme on the UGC Utsah Portal
- Monthly NEP updates must be put up on the online portal.
- International Conference for SWD students in January-February 2024.
- Malhar and IMG will be the major festivals. For other department fests and events, 50% will be conducted in one academic year and the remaining 50% in the next academic year.
- The College Management will take a call on whether we will go for Cluster University or a Private University.
- Data is being collected for AQAR 2022-2023.
- NEP preparations for the second year of 2024-2025 will begin soon.

Review:

- The NEP structures for Arts, Science Commerce, Self-financing Courses, and PG courses were discussed. The PG Courses does not offer OE, VEC, VSC & IKS. These are major intensive courses. PG Departments have been given the freedom to frame their programmes.
- If the students exit after one year, they will get a PG Diploma. This is as per the NEP norms. If the students continue for the second year, they will be awarded a PG Degree.


Any other Business:

Action Taken Report: 8th July - 9th October 2023

- Dr. Radha Kumar conducted the Course on the Indian Knowledge Systems (IKS). Dr. Pratiba Naitthani conducted an online course on the Constitution of India. It was hosted on the Learning Management System (LMS) of our new ERP Qual campus. Offline interactions were conducted and will be held to clarify doubts.

- Our college has organized some exchange programmes. We have also signed MoUs with Fordham University and Marquette University. Loyola University has proposed a course which has been incorporated into one of our Courses in Sociology. We have also signed an MOU with TCS for a Certificate Course in 'Clinical Data Management System' for the Biological Science students.

• Under NEP there are long gaps between the lectures in the timetable for the students, work is in process to streamline it.

Any other Business:

- ECC Points are given to students at the end of the activities. There is an ECC website, which is revamped. The students are made aware of this website at the time of Orientation. ECC is called Co-Curricular under NEP.
- Cleanliness is a concern on the campus. The Student Council needs to discuss this and come up with a solution.
- Career Katta: these are compulsory courses. Students will be charged Rs. 365/during the admission. A summary of this will have to be submitted to the Government at the time of submission of the Salary Bills.
- Financial Literacy and Arthniti: every student will open a Bank Account starting with Rs.100/-. The details will be on the Government portal in the next 4-5 months.
- The next meeting will be held in December-January.

Approval of minutes held on 10th October 2023

• A Resolution to pass the minutes of the meeting was proposed by Dr. Priya Sundarrajan and seconded by Dr. Geeta Ibrahim.

Action Taken Report: 10th October 2023 – 3rd January 2024

- In this new year we need to have ideas to see how things can be taken differently and start some new programmes under NEP.
- A meeting of the principals was held in November at the University of Mumbai. They will be meeting again in February. There was good feedback on the matters related to financial literacy. We could organize a session for our teaching and nonteaching staff and can be extended to the students as well. It could be part of our IQAC event.
- Training sessions for teachers to do the attendance entry on the online portal have started from 2nd January 2024.
- Inputs were given on the Environment Audit. There was an issue regarding the cleanliness of the ladies' washrooms. After a meeting with the Administrator, the washrooms are being cleaned three times a day.
- Career katta has been implemented in other districts in Maharashtra. The college must educate students to opt for these programmes. Weekly programmes are made available for students for three years. Students from the Commerce section have already registered. We need to encourage other students to register as well. The fees of Rs.365/- should be charged in the fee receipt from the First year itself. Second-year students can register next year.
- The DQAC members have submitted the AQAR and have uploaded the ADMS. The opening of the AISHE portal for 2022-2023 is awaited. The NIRF data will be submitted by 12th January 2024.
- The seed money has been sanctioned to the members of six departments, namely. Geology – 2, Botany – 2, Biotechnology – 1 and Ancient Indian Culture – 1.
- TAQs are being conducted through ERP and will be discussed with the faculty.
- The End Semester Exams for the IKS course have been conducted in hybrid mode. It is well appreciated by the Maharashtra Government and our College has been asked to share our syllabus with them.

- Principal, Dr. Rajendra Shinde and Dr. Karuna Gokarn were invited to St. Xavier's College, Simdega on 18th December 2023, to mentor them for their NAAC preparations.
- The DBT Government of Indian officials will visit SXCM on 5th January 2024. for the 'DBT Builder Grant' status.
- The College Alumni Dinner will be on 6th January 2024.

- Verification of the AQAR data for 2022-2023.
- The data collection for 2022-2023 is in process. The departments have started collecting data.
- NEP syllabi preparation for SY Semester III & IV and PG part II for 2024-2025 and TY Semester V & VI for 2025-2026.
- IDP for 5 years/15 years is being drafted. We need to have an institutional development plan for this. A Seminar on Becoming a university will be organized on 20th January 2024,
- Workshops for faculty on Course Mapping and OBE.
- The Annual Academic and Administrative Audit of our College will be conducted on 20th February 2024.
- International Conference for SWD students on 19th & 20th January 2024.
- Passing of the AQAR for 2022-2023 will be in April followed by submission.
- Plans to make a School System. The structure will change. Students can drop one subject from the same faculty based on merit in SY.

Any other Business:

- Workshop on CO-PO mapping and attainment. Uniformity in courses and evaluation is required for this. It could be introduced in the Second Year NEP syllabus. Question papers could be mapped easily with the help of this system.
- Direct attainment will be used for mapping in the End Semester Exams and CIAs. 60% of the COA will be represented by DA. 20% will be done by using a courseend survey, which will be administered to students by the department. COA = 80% DA+ 20% IDA. The calculation will be done at the ERP level. This is a NAAC requirement. A Seminar for the Staff could be conducted to understand this system.
- The next meeting will be April 2024.
