IQAC Report 2024-25

The theme for 2024 -2025 was Synergising Collaboration: The African philosophy of *Ubuntu*—"I am because you are, you are because we are"—highlights the essence of interdependence and interconnectedness. Synergising collaboration draws from this spirit, bringing together diverse talents, perspectives, and resources to achieve shared goals. It is a powerful means to foster creativity, mutual respect, and inclusive, participatory academic and civic communities.

At St. Xavier's College, an empowered autonomous institute, the UG and PG curricula are designed to reflect this vision. The education imparted aims to support the ever-learning spirit of the upskilling, new generation, including the teaching fraternity.

From 2023-24, St. Xavier's College, Mumbai, implemented the NEP 2020, incorporating multiple exit points, interdisciplinary courses, elective choices, and an emphasis on Indian Knowledge Systems. The current academic year, 2024-25, is the second year of NEP 2020.

The IQAC meetings were held in a hybrid mode on Zoom on 27 July 2025, 26 October 2024, 8 February 2025, and 8 April 2025.

New Academic Programmes

All SY, TY, HY -UG and PG-2 programs were redesigned based on the NEP 2020 credit framework. In addition, 3 new programmes will be introduced in the academic year 2025-2026:

Teaching Faculty:

Seed money outcome for 2022-23: The findings have been accepted for publication "Fungal Peptidomelanin: A Novel Biopolymer for the Chelation of Heavy Metals" by ACS Omega journal.

 - A workshop on "*Personal Mastery and Performance in Jesuit Institutions*" was conducted by Prof. Jomon from XLRI. The session was well-attended, drawing participation from 130 faculty members across SXCM, SXIE, XIMR, and XIE.

Students:

- Xynergy 2025 (Igniting Minds, Shaping Futures - Interdisciplinary Exhibition and Research Poster Presentation), also commemorating National Science Day celebrations, were held on 25th February 2025.
- Alumni Dinner was held on Saturday, 21 December 2024.
- NCC was implemented, and the ANO is Arun Singh. 17 students were selected as the first batch.
