Approval of minutes held on 8th February 2025.

- Our college is in the second year of NEP, and will be going into the third year of NEP in the next academic year, 2025-2026.
- A Resolution to pass the minutes of the meeting was proposed by Ms.
 Norine D'Souza and seconded by Dr. Geeta Ibrahim.

Action Taken Report: 9th February 20205 to 7th April 2025

- Fourth-year syllabi for the UG courses were passed by the department BoS and the AC held on 28th & 29th March 2025. The hard work put in by HODs and every member of the department was appreciated. The fourth-year syllabi are important for the TY batch of 2025-26 to know the courses being offered in the honours year (HY).
- New Programmes: 3 new programmes will be introduced in the academic year 2025- 2026:
 - a) M.A. in Transformational Leadership conducted by 'Teach for India'
 - b) B.Sc. in Biotechnology & Computational Biology
 - c) B.Sc. in Data Science & AI
 - d) B.A. in Economics-Statistics (Self-financed division)
- Xynergy 2025 (Igniting Minds, Shaping Futures Interdisciplinary Exhibition and Research Poster Presentation), also commemorating National Science Day celebrations, were held on 25th February 2025.
- Workshops and orientation programs for On-Screen-Marking (OSM) and paper setting on ERP for course attainment were conducted.
- Paper setting on ERP was done for all courses. Papers were set for 360 students for the first time by the ERP. 1,772 answer sheets were scanned for the PG. From the next academic year, it will be executed for the UG as well. Computer labs will be made available for corrections.
- Gender Cell workshops were conducted for the teaching, non-teaching staff & students on Sexual Harassment at Workplace. Some workshops were held for the SY classes, including the PG students. POSH workshop was also conducted.
- Events on Women's Day Celebration (8th March) were 1. Health awareness session for women and 2. Games and fun session.
- A workshop on effective communication for the non-teaching staff was conducted by Fr. Gordon Daniells from XIC.
- Facilitating internships: most of our students are placed. Our Placement Cell Departments, as well as Alumni, are helping with internships for the students.
- The Rotation of Heads of the Departments will be from June 2025, depending on the completion of 4 years of the current Head. The University of Mumbai also follows this system.
- The Ph.D. coursework syllabus was approved in the Academic Council meeting that was implemented in April 2025. The first part of the coursework was completed on 8th April. The next course will begin in June.
 - A workshop was conducted by Prof. Jomon from XLRI on "Personal Mastery and Performance in Jesuit Institutions" It was well attended by 130 faculty members from SXCM, SXIE, XIMR and XIE.

- Thanks to Dr. Geeta Ibrahim and Dr. Aldon Fernandes for their valuable contribution to the IOAC; they have completed their tenure of 3 years.
- · We are expecting new changes in the NAAC attributes/criteria. Therefore, there may be changes in the composition of the IQAC. The 3 new Professors appointed on the IQAC will continue.
- Thanks to the Principal, Dr. Rajendra Shinde; this is his last IQAC meeting.
- The IQAC is a guiding force. The principal suggested that new ideas are welcome and could be shared with the IQAC for implementation. Since we have started the Seed Money for the teaching faculty, it could be opened to students through E-Cell as a kind of fellowship for one year. The process could begin in March or April and be completed in February-March. Departments could be asked to appeal to Alumni to assist with these kinds of projects.
