- Work-Life Balance feedback form: a questionnaire of 36+12= 48 questions is prepared for the teachers regarding their work life.
- Seed money proposal presentation was held at the end of November 2022. Sanction letters were disbursed on 23rd December 2022. The departments of Mathematics, Geology, Microbiology, Zoology & Life Science have submitted their proposals. The proposals will be reviewed after 6 months. The initiative taken by the Management for the disbursement of the seed money is well appreciated.

Plans Ahead:

- Curricula structuring as per the NEP 2020 norms is underway. A special NEP Committee was appointed for the same to accomplish tasks under NEP. Departments will be re-designing the syllabi and getting approvals from BOS and Academic Council. The fee structure will be reviewed by the Finance Committee.
- As per UGC requirements the Research and Ethics Committee will have to be renamed as 'Research & Development Cell'.
- The CIA-II to be conducted from $11^{th} 17^{th}$ February 2023.
- 'Science Day' celebrations on 28th February 2023. Exhibitions, talks or activities can be conducted at the department level.
- The Yoga Committee would be conducting sessions for Students with Disabilities (SWD) in February 2023.
- End Semester Practical Exams will be held from 6th 17th March 2023. TAQs will be filled online by students to avail of hall tickets for ESE.

Review:

- In the NEP system curricula and syllabi will give an opportunity to upgrade and concretize courses.
- Slow and advanced learners, we need a strategy to understand.
- Credit system for Certificate Courses, Diploma and PG Diploma need to be uniform across departments in the college. The credits could be 20 for Certificate, 40 for Diploma and 60 for PG Diploma courses.
- The Policies review by the respective Committees is required. The HR Policy is the need of the hour.

NEP Preparation – first draft:

- BMM, BMS, BAF and Commerce do not have any combinations (single core) hence they will be 4 credit programmes. BSc (IT) may need to have 5 credits since they have practicals.
- Arts: have an option of 3-3-2-1 (190 credits) or 3-3-3-1 (176 credits). Students can do MOOC Courses, or visiting faculty could be appointed for the extra courses to be taught.
- <u>Science</u>: departments with only UG courses will float new courses to protect workload. The total credits will be 210.

- Decided to opt for Department Specific Courses under the NEP system.
- The End Semester Exams for the PG courses were conducted.
- The online TAQ form was opened for students on 11th February 2023.TAQs are processed and will be distributed to faculty on 29th Apr after the staff meeting.

Updates:

- The date for AQAR is extended and will be submitted in the first week of May 2023. Criterion 1: The internship certificates as proofs have the personal details of the students causing privacy concerns. Need updates in the ERP so that department-wise data upload on the Mastersoft ERP for documentation could be downloaded.
- The PG Diploma Courses can have 60 credits at all levels. Students should give completion certificates at the end of the internship. They could fill out Google forms to provide their internship certificates after completion.
- Department BOS meetings are completed.
- Work-life balance feedback for teachers will be taken soon.
- On-screen marking (OSM) is being tested with two PG departments Geology and Botany.
- Entrance Examinations for self-financed programmes are in process.

- Department of Marathi: The Junior College teacher can come as a visiting faculty for the Marathi subject. In collaboration with the Language Lab, we can come up with Communication Skills Courses in Marathi. At the moment we can target the Marathi language, during the course of the year we can think of starting Sanskrit.
- Options for becoming a University Private, Cluster, and deemed to be University were discussed. Cluster University seemed to be feasible.
- International Conference for SWD will be organized in Jan-Feb 2024
- Malhar and IMG as major fests. Other Fests 50% in current AY & remaining in next academic year. Some academic component in all fests is mandatory.
- Academic Audit to be done in 2024.
- Apply for Parmarsh scheme.
- SWD supervision to be is given to all faculty and not only the new faculty.
- PG departments should submit exam timetables to the Exam Department so that they are not given supervision on the days of their exams.

Review:

- Fee structure under NEP is not yet finalized, maybe a 20-25% rise for all courses under aided and unaided programs.
- Option for School System under the NEP system will be reviewed.
- Extra-Curricular and Co-Curricular under NEP mean the same. Science students can do CEP in the 3rd Semester since it involves fieldwork.
- Students who have taken Biological Sciences as Major Courses cannot take other Biological Sciences subjects as a Minor. The VP of Arts and Science will decide on the combinations in consultation with the Heads with the present structure in place.
- AEC (2 Languages) same for all students. All the Science departments should calculate the workload under the NEP framework. SWD students who cannot do languages can go ahead with Library Science.
